The Regina Children's Justice Centre (RCJC) is a child-friendly integrated unit where police and child protection workers, along with partners from the Victim Services Unit, Regina Qu'Appelle Health Region, and the Crown Prosecutor's Office, operate as a team to review and respond to reports of the physical or sexual abuse of children. The mission statement of RCJC is to provide an integrated investigation into allegations of child abuse in a manner that minimizes trauma to the child victim.

A full-time Victim Services Responder situated within RCJC enables a timely comprehensive victim service response. The responder initially works in close partnership with the RCJC investigators and social workers. The supportive services continue once the investigative necessities have been met. The RCJC Victim Services Responder ensures children and their caregiver(s) have access to programs such as Victim Compensation, Victim Impact Statements, Victim Witness services and information or referrals to any resources to assist in their trauma recovery.
