Children's Services, Child and Youth Program, Mental Health and Addiction Services, Saskatoon Health Region

Mental Health and Addictions Services (MHAS) is one of several care groups coordinated and organized within the Saskatoon Health Region (SHR). The Saskatoon Health Region serves the City of Saskatoon as well as a fairly wide rural area outside of the city of Saskatoon. Mental Health Services and Addiction Services combined into one care group in 2001 and provides a range of inpatient and outpatient clinical services for clients of all ages who may face mild, moderate or severe issues.

Children's Services is a program within the Child and Youth Program, MHAS that provides mental health services to children and their families from birth to age 12. The multi-disciplinary team at Children's Services is comprised of psychologists, clinical social workers, community mental health nurses, mental health therapists, case managers and a speech and language therapist. Children's Services offers assessment, treatment and consultation around mental health related concerns as well works with a number of community based partnerships and programs to provide services to children and their families who may not otherwise be able to access these services.
