The Saskatoon Centre for Children's Justice (SCCJ) provides a child-friendly, accessible and safe environment where Police and other professions can interact with children who are victims of abuse. Along with Police, the Centre is integrated with partners from the SPS Victim Services Unit, Saskatchewan Health Region, and the Crown Prosecutor's Office. Together, we operate as a team to review and respond to reports of physical and/or sexual abuse of children.

We have a full time Victim Services Responder within the SCCJ which allows for an immediate and thorough victim services response. The Victim Services Responder ensures children and caregiver(s) have access to support services throughout the investigative and judicial processes to limit trauma and avoid re-victimization.
