What is a Case Review?

From the National Guidelines for Canadian Child Advocacy Centres/Child & Youth Advocacy Centres (2021):

"A case review is a trauma-informed, collaborative, formal process to discuss elements of the case, including the investigation, addressing any safety/risk issues for a child and family, making a plan for ongoing support, and preparing for any criminal justice process as necessary."

What are the Objectives of a Case Review?

What?

- -Provide updated case information
- -Coordinate services and interventions
- -Foster collaboration and mutual accountability
- -Make informed decisions

How?

- -Sharing of knowledge, experience and expertise of all MDT members
- -Consideration of multiple perspectives
- -Mutual support is provided
- -Review of CYAC procedures, protocols and best practices

Approaches for Meeting this Guideline

CYAC develops a written
Case Review process and protocol for
the MDT

CYAC designates a staff member to coordinate and facilitate the Case Reviews

Case Reviews occur for all cases *or* for select cases only, depending on volume of cases at the centre

What are important considerations when initiating a Case Review process?

- Development
- Commitment
- Scheduling
- Understanding and Knowledge of process and benefits

Considerations of Who Attends the Case Review?

- Considerations of Participants
- Information Sharing Legislation
- Partnership Agreements
- Internal and External Considerations



Challenges to Consider

- Scheduling
- Naming
- Structure
- Ensuring collaboration
