By offering support, providing hope, and presenting opportunities, Family Services helps people realize and create possibilities for themselves. The goal is to help people build their own healthy, vibrant tomorrow.

Services range from prevention to intervention and include: abuse prevention & trauma treatment; addictions treatment; adoption services; community education & development; counselling; employee assistance; employment services; immigrant services; intensive family & parenting services; support for youth with special needs; victim support; and youth services for homeless and at-risk youth.

Last year, more than 500 staff, together with 150 volunteers, continue to provide crucial social services in over 30 languages at 20 locations throughout the lower mainland (Vancouver, Richmond, Burnaby, New Westminister, and Surrey).
