

## **Nodin Child and Family Interventions**

Nodin Child and Family Interventions is a child, youth and adult mental health service that works with the 30 First Nation communities in the Sioux Lookout Zone.

Nodin's mental health workers fly into the remote First Nation communities to provide outpatient mental health services. Other services under Nodin include: crisis intervention services, special needs case management, traditional healing services, psychological and psychiatric services. Nodin also operates a six bed residential unit for client stabilization and assessment for youth between the ages of 12 - 17.

Nodin is a branch of the Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority. SLFNHA is governed by a Board of Directors appointed by the Tribal Councils that represent the First Nation communities in the Sioux Lookout Zone.
